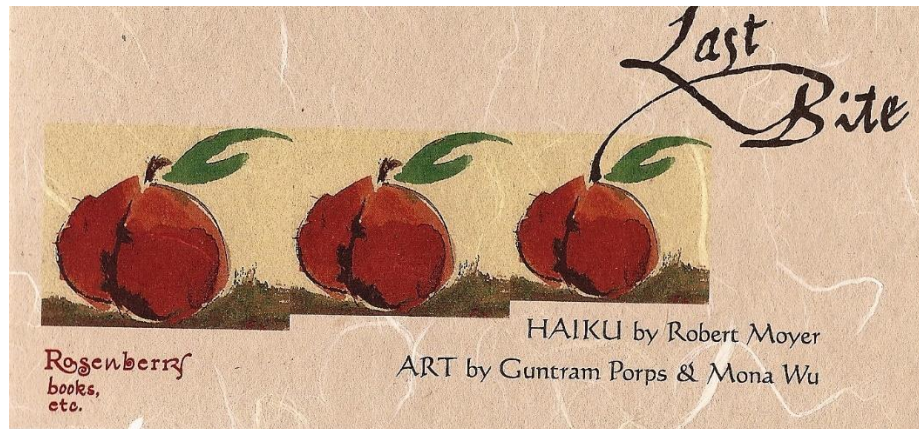


Haiku Workshops with Robert Moyer, April 18th and 19th



Robert Purcell Moyer has published articles on the teaching of haiku for the Haiku Society of America and The Haiku Foundation and has conducted writing workshops around America. His own work has been widely anthologized, most notably in 100 best poems in the first ten years of *ACORN*. His book of haiku, *The Last Bite*, was recently featured at The Lookout Gallery, Michigan State University. At the North Carolina School of the Arts, he won an Excellence in Teaching award. He is resident poet and theater artist at the Arts-Based School, a K-8 charter school.

On **April 18**, Moyer will offer a workshop to the general public at the Milne Library from 5:30-7:30 and on **April 19**, a second workshop from 5:30-7:30 at the North Adams Public Library, this one designated especially for teachers. These workshops are offered at no charge by the Hoosic River Watershed Association in conjunction with its Haiku on the Hoosic celebration May 5th.
